ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Please note the following guidelines, as you make your plans to bring high school student groups to New England Grows:

1. Student groups are invited to attend New England Grows on Friday, February 3, 2012. Pre-registration is required.
2. One instructor or responsible chaperones must accompany each group of five students. Chaperones' contact information, including cell phone numbers, will be required at check in.
3. Instructors and chaperones will be responsible for the careful supervision and oversight of students **at all times**. If students are found to be unsupervised, unruly, or cause any type of disruption, New England Grows will ask the school group to leave the event and the school will not be invited to attend in the future.
4. New England Grows must be named and held harmless in the waiver, release and/or permission forms for each student attending the event. A copy of the permission form specific to this event must be filed with New England Grows in advance. Instructors, chaperones and students are the sole responsibility of the participating school, or institution. New England Grows cannot be held responsible for any harm nor liability, arising as a result of their attendance at, or participation in, New England Grows.
